About the event in ONLINE EDITION with DISTANCING PARTICIPATION:

International English Language Week 2024 " WELCOME TO ENGLISH-SPEAKING COUNTRIES" is a prestigious cultural and language event held in Warsaw — the capital city of Poland.

Since the year 2022 International ONLINE Competition is being newly launched in a digital form as ONLINE EDITION and invites participants from different countries for distancing participation providing the chance to participate online without travelling abroad by sharing their knowledge, by creating new alternative space and opportunities for participants to challenge their creativity, to show their language skills and achievements to professional Jury and to establish new international friendly and creative contacts, to enrich the multinational culture on the basis of mutual respect for the cultural traditions of all the countries and nations of the world. The possibility for the teachers and the students to continue their co-operation as a continuation of the different EU-funded projects that have already been realized.

Aims & goals:

- The main purpose of International English Language Week 2024
 - " WELCOME TO ENGLISH-SPEAKING COUNTRIES" is to bring interesting young talents from all around the world together on the NEW digital platform without travelling abroad to present their language skills and cultural knowledge, to build collaboration among participants, to continue engaging with International contests.
- Possibility to get evaluation and Jury's votes from the recognized members of the Jury Committee and to win DIPLOMAS (in a digital electronic form) and LETTERS OF APPRECIATION (in a digital electronic form)
- Popularization of English language skills of participants from different countries.
- Sharing experiences and creative achievements of participants from different countries
- Opportunity to bring together participants from all around the world
- The best performers will be granted with certificates

General rules and regulations:

International English Language Week 2024 ONLINE " **WELCOME TO ENGLISH-SPEAKING COUNTRIES** "is determined for participants from different countries.

The procedure of participation in the ONLINE Competition:

- 1. The competition is held in the form of online competition with distancing participation in one round. The competition takes place in different forms.
- 2. Applications start being received from the Opening Date for Applications and close at the Deadline Date for accepting application.
- 3. Applications should be applied with filling in all compulsory details of participants in Application Form and being used for issuing the official Diplomas and Certificates. Teachers will be granted by the Diplomas of Appreciation.
- 4. All selected works are evaluated by the Jury Committee, represented by teachers from the Organiser, according to 10-point evaluation system (see more information in CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION AND JURY POINTS). No appeals may be lodged against the decisions of the jury.
- 5. THE OFFICIAL RESULTS of the online competition with JURY OPEN VOTES will be published in 10 working days after the Deadline Date for Applications. The Jury members have no right to disclose the results of the online competition before their official announcement.

Evaluation criteria:

The jury evaluates the skills of the participants during the competitive performance in each competitive discipline in accordance with 10-point evaluation system:

- up to 6.9 points Diploma of Participation
- 7-7.9 points Laureate of the 3rd degree
- 8-8.9 points Laureate of the 2nd degree
- 9-9.9 points Laureate of the 1st degree
- 10 points and more from all JURY MEMBERS GRAND PRIX WINNER







According to the Results, duplication of prize places is allowed (two or more third places, two or more second ones, etc.). The JURY may divide the prize places and title of Laureate (1st / 2nd / 3rd Degree) among several participants, and also not award it to anyone in a particular competitive discipline. The JURY has the right not to award the title of GRAND PRIX in a particular competitive discipline, based on the number of participants and the level of skills. The JURY has the right to award SPECIAL JURY PRIZE as well.

No participation fee.

Prize giving ceremony and awards:

According to the average score of the collected evaluation points from ALL JURY MEMBERS, all participants will be awarded DIPLOMAS OF PARTICIPATION with DIPLOMANT DEGREE, DIPLOMAS OF LAUREATE of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd DEGREE, DIPLOMA OF GRAND PRIX WINNER

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: All Diplomas and Certificates for distance participation are issued and sent to participants in DIGITAL ELECTRONIC form only.

Important conditions and obligations:

- 1. All materials created in the frames of online competition, the Organizers consider their property, have the right to use and distribute information at their discretion without paying fees to the participants.
- 2. Applying to online COMPETITION, the participants automatically accept the GENERAL REGULATIONS and CONDITIONS.
